The Build Fellowship

An Innovative Cap-Exempt H-1B Solution

The Build Fellowship is a nationwide cap-exempt H-1B program trusted by top immigration attorneys from across the U.S. with a 99% petition approval rate with USCIS.

Build Fellows are employed part-time by The Fellowship's cap-exempt non-profit partners working 5 hours per week supporting U.S. colleges & universities. Build Fellows are then able to work full-time for U.S. companies who file a concurrent H-1B visa.

Your Clients Can Qualify, Apply, & Work within 8–10 Weeks

Step 1: Qualify & Apply

Foreign nationals who qualify for a standard H-1B and have an employer, business, or sponsor fund The Build Fellowship.

Step 2: Part-Time H-1B

Build Fellows work 5 hours per week with one of Build's cap-exempt organizations, allowing The Fellow to receive a part-time cap-exempt H-1B.

Step 3: Full-Time H-1B

U.S. employers can now file a concurrent, full-time H-1B allowing the Fellow to work 40 hours per week under this concurrent H-1B.

The Build Fellowship by Open Avenues is a nationwide, cap-exempt H-1B visa program offered to foreign national experts and innovators seeking to grow companies and careers in the U.S.

Build Fellows are employed part-time by The Build Fellowship non-profit partners and are able to work full-time for U.S. companies who provide concurrent sponsorship.

Candidate Qualifications

A Bachelor's degree or demonstrated expertise in a specialized field.

Exhibit a commitment to dedicate 5+ hours weekly to support education initiatives and workforce development.

Candidates must have a benefactor willing to support the Fellowship costs – Fellows cannot fund their own Fellowship.

Sponsoring a Fellow

Candidates are nominated by full-time employers or a fiscal sponsor.

Sponsors partner with The Build Fellowship to offer the opportunity to the foreign national.

Fellow Responsibilities

Work 5+ hours per week remotely with Build's education and research partners on 1:1 lecture and mentorship sessions and experiential learning projects in the Fellow's specialized field.

Hours are flexible based on Fellow schedule.

Program Length

Fellows are accepted on a rolling basis and can start the program at any time of the year.

Fellowships last a minimum of 12 months and up to three years – an additional three year extension is possible.

Our Pricing Model

Build & the Company Employ the Fellow

Company pays Build \$4000 per month. Fellow is employed by both Build & the Company and they both entities manage the immigration needs.

- + Build employs the foreign national in the Fellowship for 5 hours per week and sponsors them for a part-time, cap-exempt H-1B visa.
- + Company employs the foreign national and sponsors them for a full-time, concurrent H-1B visa.
